Retired Marine Lt. Col. Thomas Mooney II, 55, will be buried at 3 p.m. Monday in the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific. Punchbowl.

A resident of Huntington Beach, Calif., he died in a plane crash in the

Virgin Islands recently.

Lt. Col. Mooney was chief pilot for an airline in California and had flown combat missions in World War II and the Korean and Vietnam wars. In recent years he had been a stunt pilot for such television series as "The Black Sheep Squadron," "Charley's Angels" and "The Six Million Dollar Man."

He is survived by his wife Gloria.
